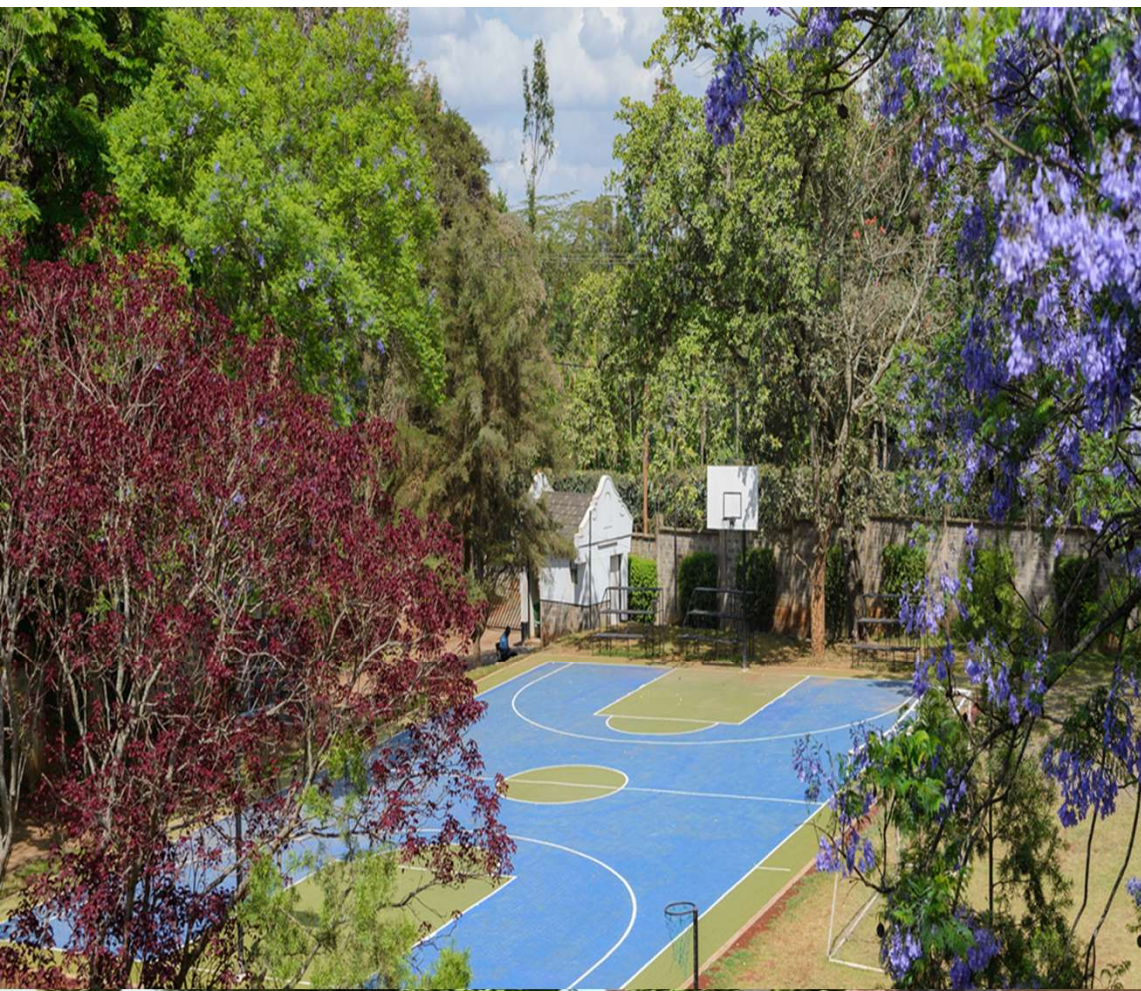

KCSE ANALYSIS

Learners at St. Hannah's consistently perform impressively in national exams. In **KCSE 2024**, the girls' high school achieved a mean grade of **7.6 (B-)** with two students scoring A plain and two A-. The boys' high school achieved a mean grade of 7.4 (C+) with one A plain and three A-.

KCSE ANALYSIS⁵

For KCSE 2023, the boys' high school secured a mean grade of B- with the top student scoring 83 out of 84 points, earning an A plain — the highest individual achievement in that year. William Ernest Sungura from 3dee Campus attained an impressive grade of A - in KCSE 2024. In addition, Adribert Uwiragiye from 3 Dee got an A- in the KCSE 2023 and currently pursuing Mechanical Engineering in Japan.

In the 2024 KCSE examinations, Consolata Wanjiru from 3Dee achieved the coveted grade of A, while her classmate Sally Kimondo distinguished herself with an impressive A-.

5. Transitional Discount

Students joining directly from St. Hannah's Junior School enjoy a 10% discount on tuition and boarding fees for the entire Grade 10 year.

6.Value Addition

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- **Internal assessments indicate that over 95% of learners transitioning from our primary campuses attains a minimum grade of B- in high schools.**
